Dear Residential Customer:

The Streets Department will pick up and dispose of garbage and yard waste in accordance with the following policies:

- All garbage and refuse must be bagged and placed in the provided roll out cart. The occasional overflow garbage bag and flattened cardboard boxes should be placed at least an arm's length away from the cart.
- The roll out cart should be placed at the curbside in such a way as to not block passage of the sidewalk or street. The front/opening of the cart must face the street; the handle should be pointed away from the street. Place cart 6' away from mail boxes, fire hydrants, telephone/power poles, fences, vehicles and other obstructions.
- Carts must be at the curb by 7:00 am on collection day and returned to the side or rear of your residence no later than 24 hours after collection of the garbage. Do not get accustomed to a certain time for garbage collection as unforeseen problems do arise which may change the collection time.
- The Town provides a bin for curbside recycling. The following items are accepted: newspapers, rinsed out plastic bottles such as soft drink bottles, milk jugs, any type of plastic (no caps, please), and aluminum cans. Your recycle bin needs to be placed 5' away from roll-out container.
- Yard waste cannot be placed in containers or mixed with appliances, metal or household articles. Anything mixed with yard waste will not be picked up. Do not place yard waste in your household roll out cart.
- Yard waste should be organized into like piles. Limbs are chipped curbside and should be no more than 8' long, less than 8" in diameter, and manageable by one person.
- From October through March, the Town picks up leaves using a leaf vacuum. Rake leaves to curb for collection, taking special care not to mix the piles with sticks, rocks or other debris that can damage the leaf machine.
- Do not place leaves or any other object anywhere that will block storm drains, sidewalks or roadways.
- The Town does NOT collect hazardous materials, such as batteries, paint, or flammable liquids; tires; or any white goods, such as stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, air conditioners or hot water heaters or e-trash, such as TV's or computers. However, a "spring clean" week is held each May for curbside collection of such items. The event will be announced on the Town's website and Facebook pages and in the monthly newsletter *Clover Leaf*.
- The Town does NOT collect yard waste, building materials or refuse from building operations or landscape contract work. The contractor is responsible for removing these items.
- The Town will NOT collect any item that cannot be safely handled or loaded onto a truck by the Town's crew or any accumulation of yard waste that is the result of land clearing.
- There are three York County Convenience Centers in the Clover area: (1) Paraham Rd., (2) Bethel School Rd., and (3) Highway 161 near McGill's Crossroads. Visit www.yorkcountygov.com for a list of items accepted at the Convenience Centers.
